INNER CLUB TOURNAMENT RULES

SCORECARDS

All scorecards must be legible and include the player's First and Last Name. All scorecards must be signed, attested and dated. All score cards must be turned in to the Pro Shop at the end of the round. A score card that is illegible or not turned in may result in the player's disqualification from tournament or skins prizes. Everyone is responsible for posting their own scores and skins results on the sheets posted in the Pro Shop.

GHIN SCORE ENTRY

In accordance with USGA rules, all scores, whether playing 9 or 18, white or blue must be put into the GHIN system. You should use the ECS table to adjust your score before putting it in the system. In tournament play you should finish a hole and not merely "award" yourself the maximum score for handicap purposes, although in a team event you should pick up when you are out of a hole to improve the pace of play.

ATTESTING OF SCORECARD

Any type of Member (i.e. weekday, no frills) can attest a scorecard. If playing in a 2-person event, you must have at least one other member in your group to attest your card.

RULES

It is up to everyone to abide by USGA and local rules. Other than in match play events, no putts are conceded (so don't ask). If you commit an infraction, announce it to your playing partners. If anyone sees an infraction, it is incumbent on them to protect the field by bringing it to the attention of the player committing the infraction and the rest of the group. If there then remains a question about the infraction a member of the rules committee should be notified. If there is a question about a rules interpretation, the player should play 2 balls and record both scores until a member of the rules committee can be contacted.

- **All meaningful putts must be holed out.**
- **If in doubt where you hit your ball, always hit a provisional to help the speed of play.**
- **If you need to touch your ball to identify it, you must let someone in your group know.**
- **In your own fairway,** you may move the ball with your club 6 inches for preferred lie.
- **In your own fairway,** if your ball is on a rock or bare patch, you get full relief to nearest grass no nearer to the hole.
- Be aware of local rules. They are on-line and will be posted in Pro Shop.

Based on the course conditions, the tournament committee will make a determination of whether players will be permitted to lift clean and place their ball in their own fairway. When the lift clean and place rule is in effect, the player should mark the ball and then place it by hand within a club length of the original spot no nearer to the hole.

You must be a paid 7 Day member of Winnapaug and at least 18 years old to join the Inner Club.

Make checks payable to Winnapaug Men's Club and give to Chris Jurgasik or Tom Hogan. To play in the Club Championship and Presidents Cup, you must have at least 6 rounds posted for the current year prior to the event. To play in the 4-Ball you must have at least 10 rounds posted for the current year prior to the event.

To play in the Sr. Club Championship you must have at least 4 rounds posted for the current year prior to the event.
